Educational Background and Professional experience:

He did his graduation in Electronics Engineering, masters in Nuclear Engineering and did specialization in PSA and I&C evaluations for nuclear reactor safety in Italy, UK and Germany. He started his career in nuclear field in Mid 70's in Safety Division of the Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission which later became directorate. Mr. Habib remained Member of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safety in Pakistan from 1997 to 2000.

In 2001, independent nuclear regulatory authority as Pakistan Nuclear Regulatory Authority (PNRA) was formed by the Government of Pakistan. Mr. Habib became Director General (Technical) of PNRA in 2004. He was elevated as Member (Corporate) in 2007 and appointed Chairman-PNRA by the Government of Pakistan in 2009. He served as Chairman of the Authority for two full terms of the office i.e total of eight years according to the statute, until early 2017 and is currently serving as advisor to the government on nuclear regulatory matters.

Mr. Habib has a vast experience of above 40 years in the areas of safety review of nuclear power plants, research reactors and various radiation facilities. He also has experience in preparation of various Nuclear Safety Regulations and Regulatory Guides for design and operation of Nuclear Power Plants and Research Reactors and he remained involved in regulation of nuclear security aspects since its inception in regulatory matters in Pakistan. He took lead role in review of the up-gradations, followed by relicensing after the designed life of the first Nuclear Power Plant of Pakistan KANUPP and the review of preliminary and final safety analysis reports of Chashma nuclear power plants along with preparation of their safety evaluation reports for their licensing. He has also lead several delegations of Pakistan to the IAEA including, Convention on Nuclear Safety and other international conferences on Nuclear Security.

At international level, Mr. Habib has remained a Member of the IAEA Nuclear Safety Standards Committee (NUSSC) and Commission of Nuclear Safety Standards (CSS). He also remained Member of the IAEA Advisory Group on Nuclear Security (AdSec). Currently he is serving as Advisor on Nuclear regulatory matters to the Government.
